

YPS LIASON PROGRAM DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

(Updated May 2024)

- 1. Liaisons will serve a two-year term.
- 2. Liaisons will be responsible for representing the Texas Society of Pathologists (TSP), and particularly the Young Pathologists' Section (YPS).
- 3. Liaisons shall act as a conduit for disseminating important information between the TSP / YPS and trainees within their programs.
- 4. Liaisons shall help trainees within their programs connect with the TSP / YPS and promote engaged involvement with the society.
- 5. Liaisons shall represent the trainees within their programs, promoting their interests and needs to the YPS leadership to foster opportunities for growth that can be aided by YPS and TSP.
- 6. Liaison shall participate actively in TSP, including working with other committees, such as the membership committee, to increase overall engagement and representation of the YPS within the society.
- 7. Liaisons, in conjunction with the YPS Chairs and administrators, shall help organize and host regional happy hours, which are typically held mid-July.
- 8. During the liaison's second year of service, they will help to recruit and mentor incoming liaison applications from their program.
